Reflection from Fr Martin

At first sight today's Gospel comes across rather shockingly; is Jesus really suggesting that we should 'hate', and hate those closest to us? It doesn't seem to fit with the normal teaching of Jesus, nor with either his context or ours. Family is the basis of human society and experience.

But if we read this Gospel in its context then perhaps it makes more sense. Jesus is on his way to Jerusalem, having left behind his family and all the safety and security and certainty he had enjoyed. The same detachment is necessary for the disciples of Jesus; to leave behind their security in order to focus only and totally on following Jesus, the master. This is the demand and cost of discipleship. And it is a cost worth paying!

The sacrifices and difficulties we may face will be different for each of us, but nothing compared to the sacrifice of Jesus himself. He gave everything, even his life for us. Let's pray today for the grace to follow Jesus, no matter the cost, and to be faithful disciples.
